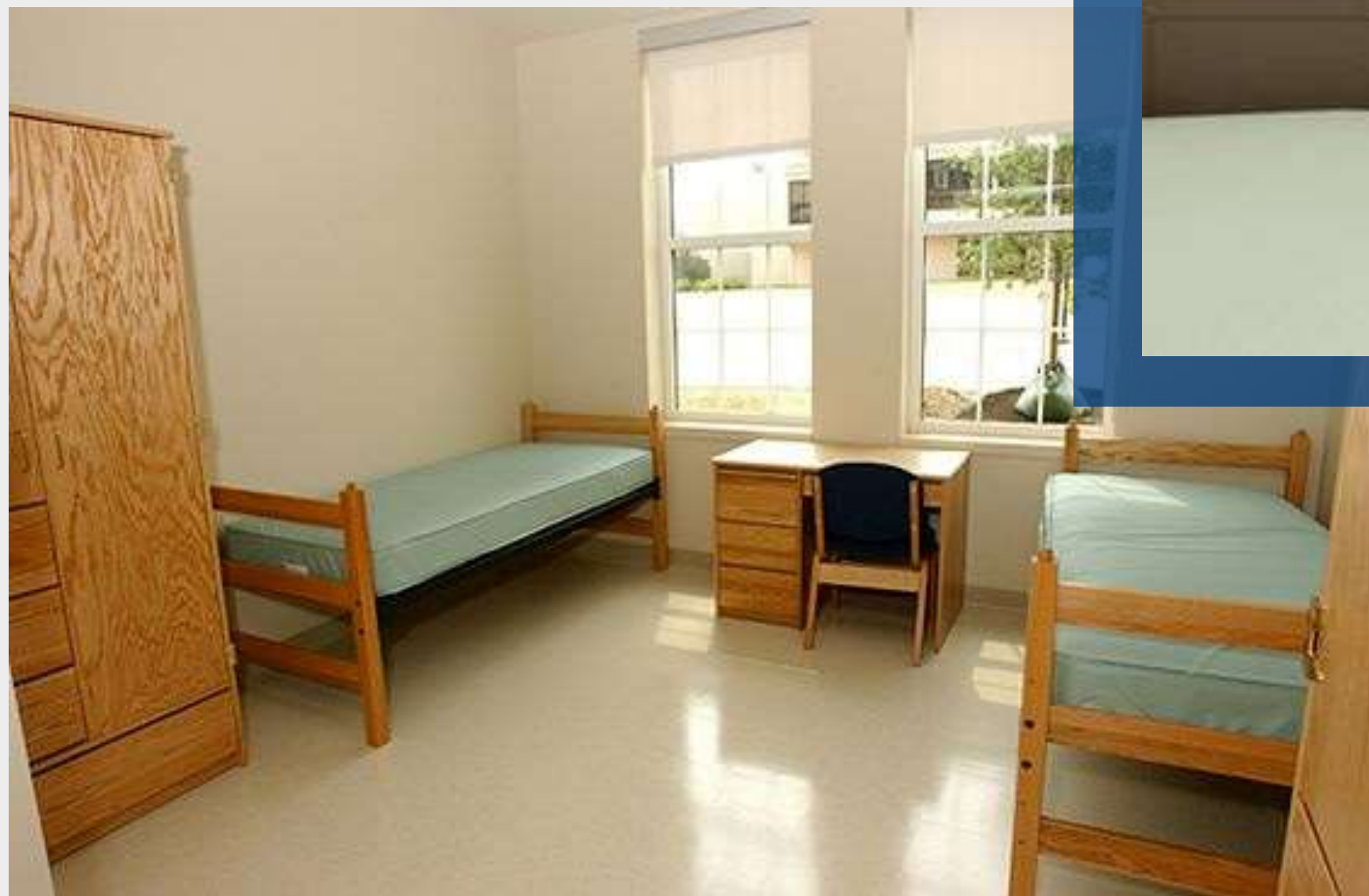
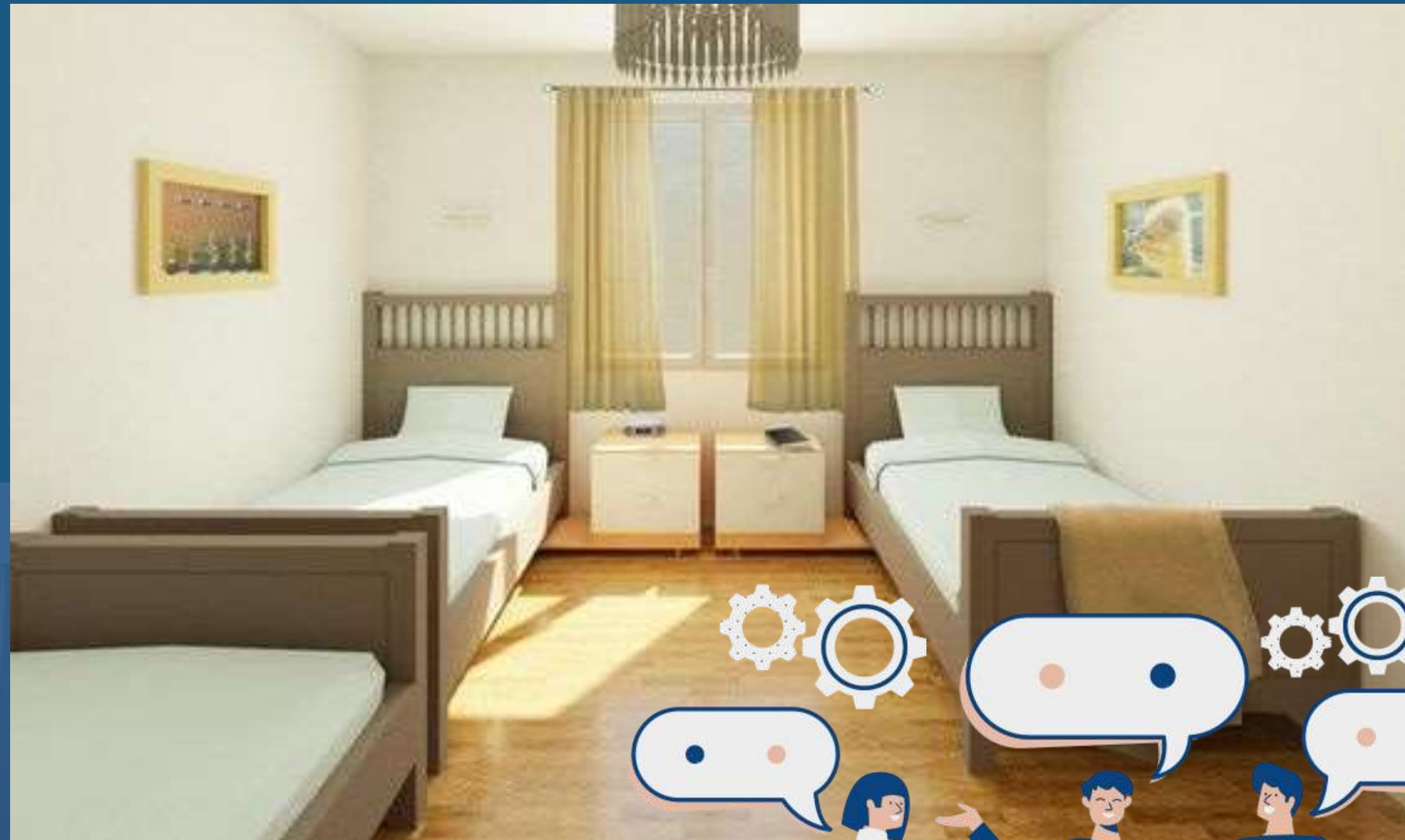

Step 3- Organize while you pack

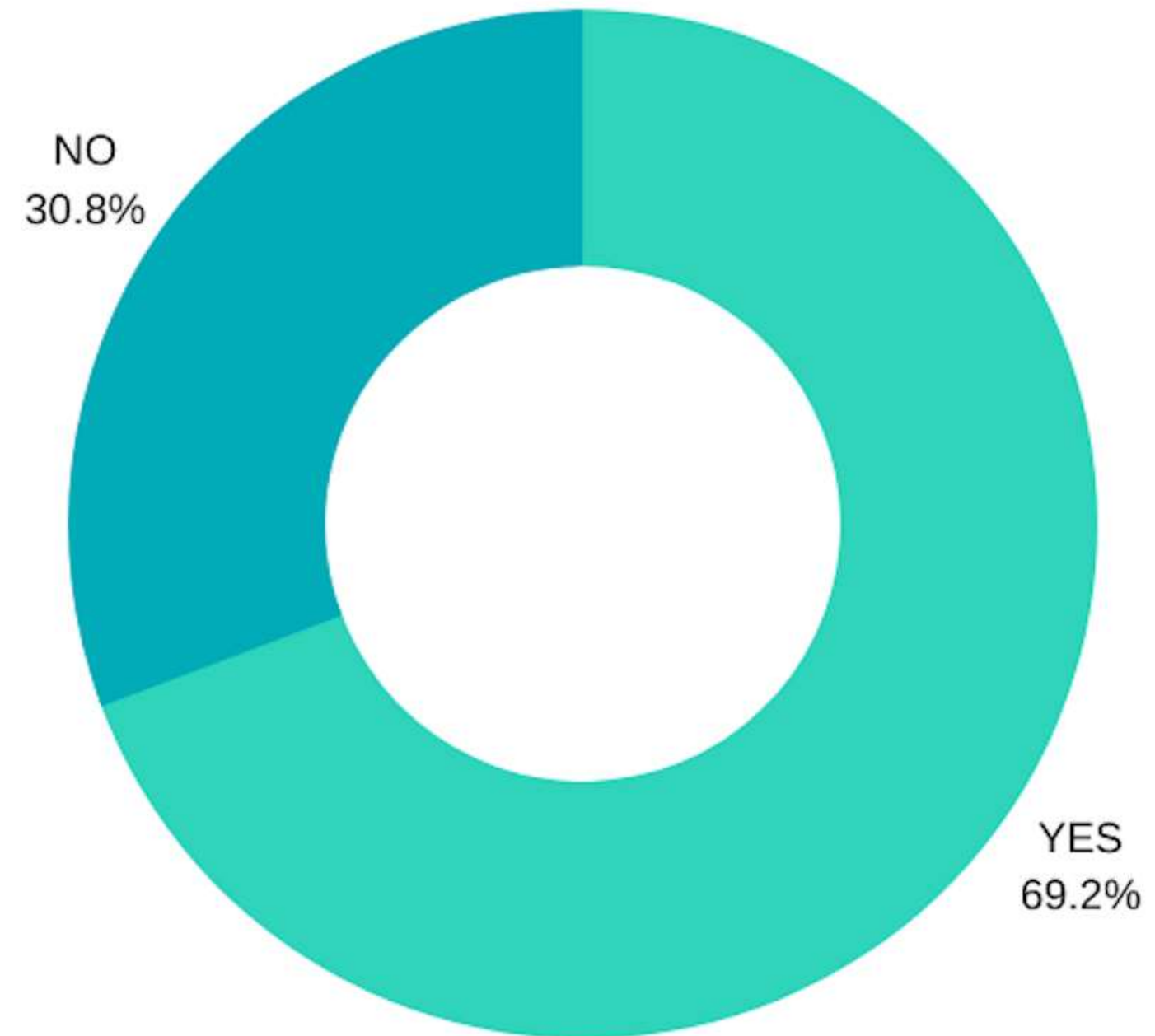


Step 4- Try to maximize dorm room space



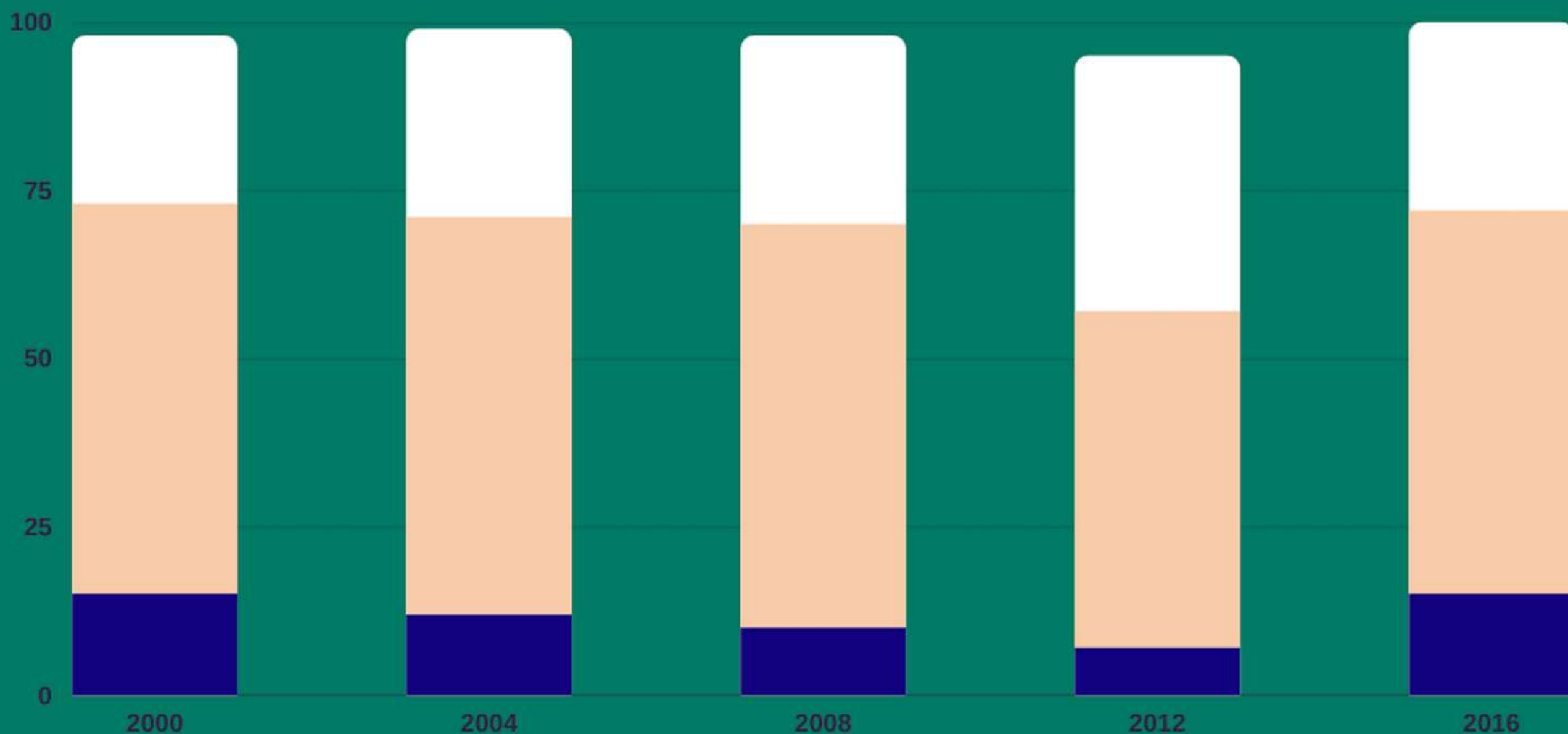

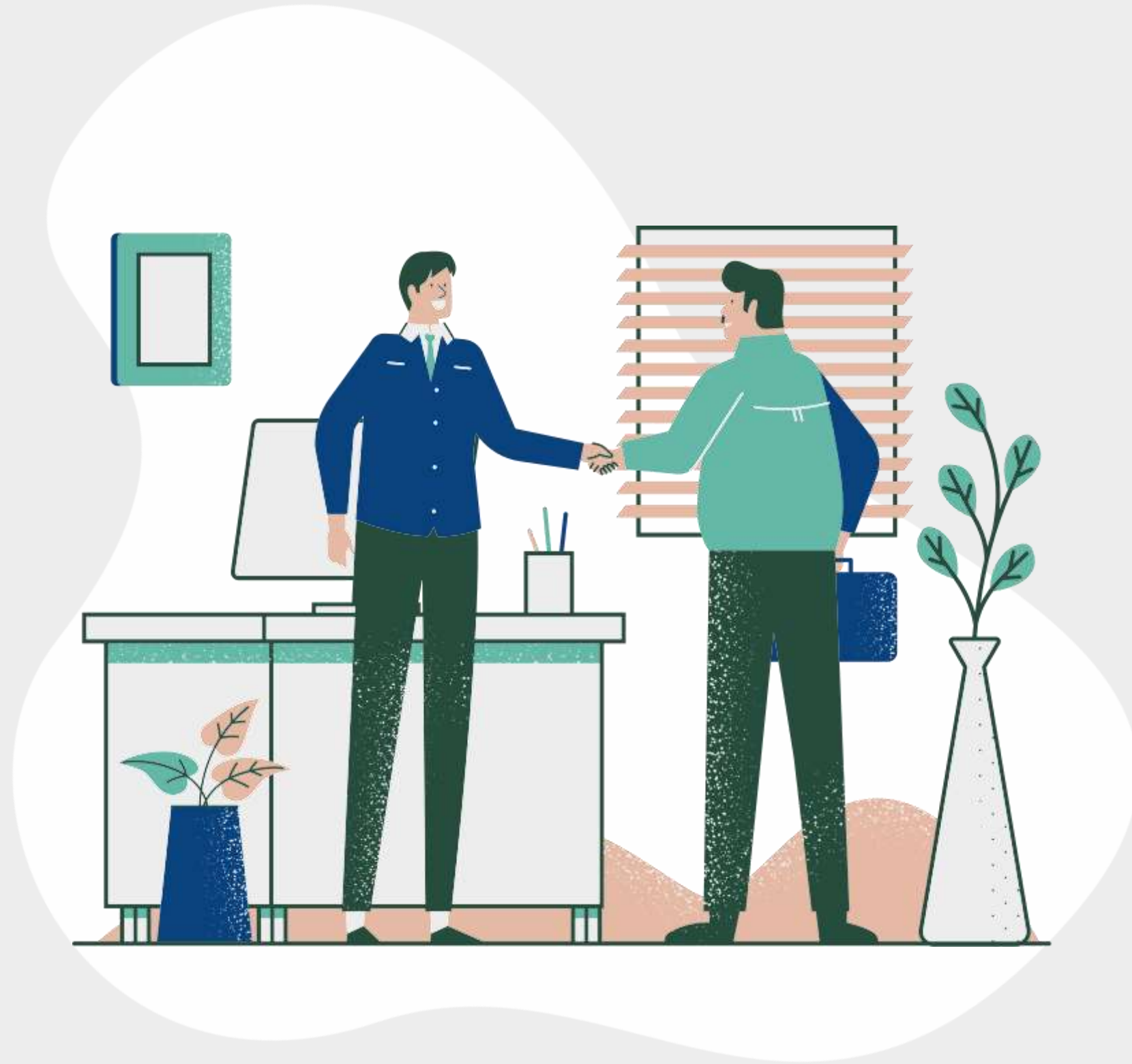
